
Elisabeth de Brabant is a contemporary art curator and consultant with over 20 years of experience curating art exhibitions collaboration programs and in with international network of museums and collectors, unmatched expertise in Contemporary Asian Art. Born in New York City, her deep connection to art stems from a family rooted in Asia since 1908, historically known as major collectors and museum benefactors. During the formative years of the Chinese contemporary art scene, Elisabeth created and curated some of the most dynamic art spaces, directing Artscene, a leading gallery in China with locations in Shanghai's French Concession, M50 Art Warehouse, and Beijing's 798 Art District. Throughout her career, she has worked on collections for esteemed institutions organizations such as The Guggenheim Museum, The MoMA, The Rockefeller Foundation, The Rothschild Family, The Whitney Museum, The Seattle Art Museum, MOCA LA, and The HSBC Art Collection.






